**Safety is Everyone's Responsibility**...Island Horse Council Biosecurity & Safety - Please ensure that each horse/pony has this year's annual and recommended vaccines for competitions and horse/ponies that leave their residence. This is to ensure every animal is safe and will have a great summer show season.

ALL horses/ponies MUST be safely tied to a safely secured horse trailer or handled by a competent handler during the event. Tying a horse/pony to any fencing on the property is strictly NOT allowed. The use of any temporary fencing to contain a horse/pony is NOT allowed at any times of the event.

## **Competition Rules & Regulations**

The **ABEGWEIT SHOW SERIES** is Provincially Sanctioned by the Island Horse Council (IHC). Please read the following Abegweit Show Series Competition Rules:

- Competitors must have a current Island Horse Council (IHC) Membership **prior to the competition.** No one may compete without proof of IHC membership.
- Out-of-Province competitors must provide with entry proof of liability insurance (membership) from their own provincial board (PSO)
- Go to [www.islandhorsecouncil.ca](http://www.islandhorsecouncil.ca) under Membership 2019 for an IHC Membership
- The competition secretary **CAN NOT** provide any competitor an IHC Membership for 2019. Temporary membership may NOT be purchased
- It is strongly recommended for all coaches, parents and riders to review the Rulebook and Competition Guidelines document available from Island Horse Council
- Competitors may be eligible to accumulate points towards the Abegweit Show Series Year End Awards
- Some divisions are considered Open but the accumulated points will be scored according to the Senior and Junior classifications as stated within the Rulebook and Competition Guidelines.
- IHC requires that **ALL** competitors must wear ASTM/SEI, or BSI/BS EN, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted anywhere on the competition grounds. The Show Committee also requires boots with a heel in all classes, in the warm-up area, and whenever mounted on the Show Grounds. If a hard hat falls off, it must be retrieved before continuing to ride.

**Competition Rules & Regulations Continued ...**

- 1) By entering the Charlottetown Pony Club's 41st Annual English Horse Show you have agreed to honor the Rules and Regulations as specified in this Prize List, within the Abegweit Show Series Rulebook and Competition Guidelines and any changes deemed necessary by the Show Committee.
- 2) Competition Numbers must be worn and visible at all times whenever mounted on the competition grounds. This includes the warm-up area and competition rings.
- 3) No riding is Permitted on the Cross- Country Field during the Competition Day.
- 4) Competitors will "Warm-up" only in the fenced in areas designated by the competition.
- 5) Competitor Age Categories: Where Age is indicated, the Age of the Competitor is defined as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this calendar year.
- 6) Ponies measure 14.2 hh and under. All ponies which show must indicated their size on the entry form.
- 7) The competition points that go towards High Pt. Divisional Championship will be calculated as a one horse/pony one rider combination. This is to encourage the Pony Club spirit of sportsmanship.
- 8) The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if less than 4 competitors per division or class. In addition, the show committee reserves the right to change schedule where deemed advisable.
- 9) The Show Committee, Charlottetown Pony Club, its officials, Island Horse Council, and Strathgartney Equestrian Park will not be held responsible for any loss, illness or injury to horse, rider, grooms, volunteers, officials and spectators at this competition.
- 10) No Hors Concors allowed for this competition.
- 11) 75% of entry fees will be refunded if a veterinarian or doctor's certificate is supplied to the Show Secretary within 3 days before or after the competition.
- 12) The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer, or other person shall not be tolerated. Such abuse of a horse may result in a penalty, forfeit of prizes and asked to leave the show grounds.
- 13) Equine Medication Control Testing – IHC reserves the right to introduce drug testing at Abegweit Show Series with the proviso that due notice will be given. The IHC endorses Clean Sport For All Equine Activities (Abegweit Rulebook & Competition Guidelines, pg.4)
- 14) Pets **MUST** be on a leash at all times while on the show grounds and not disruptive to competitors or horses/ponies during the show.
- 15) Scratches will not be reimbursed.
- 16) Official protests must be made in writing to the secretary of the competition, signed and accompanied by a \$25 cheque within 1 hour of the completion of the class in question. (Abegweit Rulebook & Competition Guidelines, pg. 8/9)
- 17) Hunter Classes are paid by division only whether you enter one or all classes. Jumper Classes are paid for on a class basis.
- 18) The Show Committee and its Officials have the right to expel any rider, owner or spectator deemed to be in their sole discretion disruptive to the show at any time.
- 19) Absolutely "NO" smoking permitted on show grounds.
- 20) All riders, grooms, attendants and handlers must be neatly dressed on entering the ring.
- 21) The use of a cell phone while mounted is not permitted on the show grounds. We encourage safety at all times.
- 22) Any horse that becomes out of control shall be eliminated from the competition at the discretion of the judge.
- 23) Lunging will not be permitted in the warm-up ring if there are more than 4 riders\*in the warm-up ring. **\*Note:** The Steward has the option to reduce this number of riders. No more than one person lunging if there are riders in the warm-up ring.
- 24) The show committee will allow one horse/pony substitution or one rider substitution if needed under certain circumstances. The secretary must be informed prior to the substitution.
- 25) As per the policy of the Canadian Pony Club, stallions are not permitted on the show grounds. This is to ensure the safety of our young riders and their mounts. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

**ENTRY DEADLINE is JULY 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019** for receipt of entries by the Show Secretary. Entry Form, Waivers, and CPC Non-Member Risk Form **must** be signed by the rider, owner, person responsible and parent (if exhibitor is under 19 years old) in order to be accepted. If rider is under 19 years of age, the entry must be signed by a **parent or legal guardian** who assumes all responsibility and risk as stated on the form and by these Rules and Regulations.

**Person Responsible:** The person who signs the entry form is the person responsible for the welfare of the horse and for the actions of the support team of that entry during the show and on-site of the competition. Junior competitors must have their entry form signed by the parent or legal guardian.

### **Competition Awards/Prizes:**

**Ribbons:** 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in every class.

**SPECIAL AWARD:** High Pt. Pony Club Member- The most points accumulated from the show by a *Current Pony Club Member*. Points must be the result of a combination of ONE rider and ONE horse/pony.

**Memorial Hunter Classic:** Adelle Coffin Memorial Hunter Classic - Memorial & Keeper Trophy

**Memorial Pony Club Jumper Class:** Ralph Manning Memorial Pony Club Jumper Class - Memorial & Keeper Trophy

**Jumper Classes:** Ribbons and Prize

### **Divisional Championships:**

- Sm/Med.Pony Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Sm/Med.Pony Hunter Division to be eligible for the High Pt. Sm/Med. Pony Hunter Prize.
- Lg. Pony Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Lg. Pony Hunter Division to be eligible for the High Pt. Lg. Pony Hunter Prize.
- Beginner Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Beginner Hunter Division, to be eligible for the High Pt. Beginner Hunter Prize.
- Intro-Low Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Intro-Low Hunter Division to be eligible for the High Pt. Intro-Low Hunter Prize.
- Low Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Low Hunter Division to be eligible for the High Pt. Low Hunter Prize.
- Horse Hunter Division - (3 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Horse Hunter Division to be eligible for the High Pt. Horse Hunter Prize.
- Walk/Trot Hunter Division- (4 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Walk/Trot Hunter Division to be eligible for the division prize.
- Short Stirrup Hunter Division- (4 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Short Stirrup Hunter Division to be eligible for the division prize.
- Cross Rail Hunter Division- (4 classes/division) Competitors must enter the Cross Rail Hunter Division to be eligible for the division prize.
- X & O's Hunter Division – (4 classes/division) Competitors must enter the X & O's Hunter Division to be eligible for the division prize.

**Competition Class Specifications:**

**All classes run under PC Table A Penalties page 33 Rulebook and Competition Guidelines Abegweit Show Series.**

**Ralph Manning Memorial Pony Club Jumper**–Maximum height/spread over fences offered: 0.70m, 0.80m, 0.88m, 0.91m. There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. Open to competitors however, only Current Pony Club members or Pony Club alumni may qualify for the Memorial Trophy. (One Round against the clock).

**Class # 1**

**Welcome Jumper – 0.91m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class # 2**

**Power & Speed Jumper – 0.91m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class #3**

**Welcome Jumper – 1.0m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class # 4**

**Power & Speed Jumper – 1.0m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class # 5**

**Welcome Jumper – 1.10m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class #6**

**Power & Speed Jumper – 1.10m height.** There will be no distances changes for ponies. Open only to residents of PEI or Atlantic Canada. **Class # 7**

**Description of the “4 Class” Miscellaneous Hunter Division:** This Hunter Division will consist of 2 over fence classes, 1 under saddle class and 1 pleasure class. The pleasure class will be shown at a flat-footed walk, normal trot and easy canter and not to gallop; light contact with the horse’s mouth; to be judged on performance, manners and conformation. In order to maintain awards, horses must compete and complete the course in at least one over fences class in their respective division. Hunter under saddle classes must never be the first class of a division.

**Horses/Ponies Entering Miscellaneous Hunter Divisions may enter 2 divisions (i.e., Cross Rail and X & O’s Hunter) except the Walk/Trot Division.**

**Walk/Trot Hunter Division (Jr. Rider 12 yrs. old and under ONLY) - (4 classes/division)** Fences will be defined as one pole on the ground between two standards to encourage the start of riding a hunter course. Rider/Pony/Horse Combination may NOT enter any other division or classes in this show. No cantering allowed in this division.  
**Classes #8, #12, #13, #20**

**Short Stirrup Hunter Division (Jr. Rider 12 yrs. old and under ONLY) - (4 classes/division)** Fences 18”. This division is to encourage the riding of a hunter course, but less fences to jump. **Classes #9, #14, #15, #21**

**Cross Rail Hunter Division (Pony or Horse) (4 classes/division)** – Fences 18”. A hunter division for inexperienced riders or horses/ponies over a course of cross rail fences. **Classes #10, #16, #17, #22**

**X and O’s Hunter Division (Pony or Horse) (4 classes/division)**– The course will include of cross rails and small verticals to a maximum of 2.0’, no oxers. **Classes # 11, #18, #19, #23**

**EQUITATION CLASSES (Basic Seat on the Flat)** - Equitation classes are divided by age groups as follows: Individuals are juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Riders will proceed at least once around the ring at each gait – walk, trot and canter, reverse and repeat. At the judge’s discretion, they may be asked to execute an individual test.

**Equitation Junior "A",** Rider who is 15, 16, 17 on January 1, 2019. **Class #24**

**Equitation Junior "B",** Rider who is 12, 13, 14 on January 1, 2019. **Class #25**

**Equitation Junior "C",** Rider who is under 12 on January 1, 2019. **Class #26**

**Maylea Manning Lead Line Class** – A class for riders 12yrs. old and under. Horses/ponies to be led by a competent handler. Handler(s) must be an adult, wear approved helmet(s) (ASTM), boots, and proper attire (no shorts). Riders under 6 must be accompanied by a second handler. Entries in this class may NOT enter any other classes. Prizes and treats to be presented. **Class #27**

**Walk/ Trot Class** - A class for riders 12yrs. old and under. To be shown at a walk and easy trot. Entries must wear approved helmets (ASTM) and boots. Entries in this class may NOT enter any other classes. Prizes and treats to be presented. **Class #28**

**Horses/Ponies Entering Hunter Divisions may only enter 2 of 4 divisions (i.e., Beginner and Intro-Low Hunter OR Intro-Low and Low Hunter)**

**Hunter O/F Division (2 O/F Classes)**: To be judged on jumping style, manners and way of going. Conformation not to count. Horses/ponies must be jogged for soundness. In order to maintain awards, horses must compete and complete the course in at least one over fences class in their respective division. Hunter under saddle classes must never be the first class of a division.

**Sm/Med. Pony Hunter Division (Pony Only)** - Maximum height/spread over fences- **Small Pony - 2'3" (0.70m), Medium Pony- 2'6 (0.80m)**. Fences in accordance with pony size. Only Junior riders eligible.

**Class # 29, #30, #42 (Under Saddle)**

**Lg. Pony Hunter Division (Pony Only)** - Maximum height/spread over fences - **Large Pony - 2'9" (0.88m)**. Fences in accordance with pony size. Please Refer to Rule #10, for more information. Only Junior riders eligible.

**Class # 35, #36, #43 (Under Saddle)**

**Beginner Hunter Division (Horses and Any pony size)** - Maximum height/spread over fences - **2'3" (0.70m)**.

Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. To complete a hunter-type jumping course of at least 8 obstacles not to exceed 2'3" (0.70m) in height. To be judged on obedience, jumping form and general way of going. Open to seniors riding horses or large ponies and juniors riding horses or ponies. The course may, but is not required to, be adjusted in height and distance for ponies. Juniors of any age may show any height of pony in miscellaneous, non-point classes. A pony shown in judged classes by an adult may not be shown by a junior in a judged class at the same competition. **Class # 31, #32, #44 (Under Saddle)**

**Intro - Low Hunter Division (Horses and Med. and Lg. Ponies)** - Maximum height/spread over fences - **2'6" (0.80m)**.

Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. To complete a hunter-type jumping course of at least 8 obstacles not to exceed 2'6" (0.80m) in height. To be judged on obedience, jumping form and general way of going. Open to seniors riding horses or large ponies and juniors riding horses or medium or large ponies. The course may, but is not required to, be adjusted in height and distance for ponies. Juniors of any age may show any height of pony in miscellaneous, non-point classes. A pony shown in judged classes by an adult may not be shown by a junior in a judged class at the same competition. **Class # 33, #34, #45 (Under Saddle)**

**Low Hunter Division (Horses and Lg. Ponies)** - Maximum height/spread over fences - **2'9" (0.88m)**. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. To complete a hunter-type jumping course of at least 8 obstacles not to exceed 2'9" (0.88m) in height. To be judged on obedience, jumping form and general way of going. Open to seniors riding horses or large ponies and juniors riding horses or large ponies. The course may, but is not required to, be adjusted in height and distance for ponies. Juniors of any age may show any height of pony in miscellaneous, non-point classes. A pony shown in judged classes by an adult may not be shown by a junior in a judged class at the same competition.

**Class #37, #38, #46 (Under Saddle)**

**Horse Hunter Division (Horses Only)** - Maximum height/spread over fences –**3'0 (0.91m)**. To complete a hunter-type jumping course of at least 8 obstacles not to exceed 3'0 (0.91m) in height. To be judged on obedience, jumping form and general way of going. Open to seniors and juniors riding horses. **Class # 39, #40, #47 (Under Saddle)**

**Adelle Coffin Memorial Hunter Classic (Horses Only)** - Maximum height/spread over fences –**3'0 (0.91m)**. Judged over two scored rounds. First round will be judged on a course of 10 fences. Second round will be judged on a course of 8 fences. To be judged on obedience, jumping form and general way of going. Open to seniors and juniors riding horses. **Class #41**

#### General Competitor/Parent/Guardian Waiver:

I acknowledge that the sport of horses is a high-risk sport and that I am participating at my own risk and in full knowledge of the hazards and potential hazards which are inherent in this sport. I further acknowledge the inherent risks in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury to both horse and rider that can result from normal use, competition or schooling. I will wear (or if a parent of a competitor under 18, I will insure my child wears) an approved hard hat at all times while mounted. As the parent of a lead line entry, I declare the handler to be a competent horseperson.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in this event, I hereby assume all risk and I hereby release and absolve the Show Committee, the Charlottetown Pony Club, Island Horse Council (IHC), and its officials, judge, volunteers, officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees, Strathgartney Equestrian Park and the owners and occupiers of the land upon which the show is held, from all responsibility, liability or claims of any nature and kind which I may have arising from my participation in this activity, including but not limited to bodily injury or death to myself or my horse(s) and damage to property arising from any cause whatever, including the negligence of one or more of the individuals and organizations referred to herein.

I hereby declare that in making this entry that I have read and fully understand and agree to the terms and conditions stated herein and that it is binding upon my executors, heirs and assigns.
